- The Texas FFA Convention now ranks among the Top 5 Association conventions in the state ٠ of Texas.
- Attendance for the last three years has averaged more than 12,000! •
- The FFA convention has an annual economic impact estimated at **\$6.5 million** to the host city! •



Past State Officer (PSO) - Challenge

The PSO Challenge is a way for former Texas FFA Officers to rise to "pay it forward" during the annual convention. PSOs are encouraged to participate as individuals or through their respective companies, organization or through their family. PSO groups are recognized on stage at convention and identified during the Foundation's annual VIP Breakfast. \$100 per PSO or \$1,000 per team is the level needed to meet "the challenge."

Guidelines and Contingencies

The Texas FFA Foundation Sponsorship Programs are designed to encourage optimum promotion for your support. To assist in helping us reach the promotional strategies of the program, a short list of guidelines have been developed to help understand the suspense dates necessary for a successful program. To ensure the highest levels of service, trust and integrity, participants are asked to honor the suspense dates for the greatest program rapport.

- The program will run annually from convention to convention. Sponsors are encouraged to sign up, and/or make their commitment as soon as possible in some cases before the next convention.
- Once a letter of commitment has been signed and agreed upon, the level of partnership participation may be paid in full or half down with the balance paid by June 20. All <u>sponsorship payments should be made to the Texas FFA Foundation</u> and denoted for Convention Sponsorship.
- All rules, guidelines and requirements of usage of the FFA logo, marks and emblem are at the direction of the Texas FFA Association and National FFA Organization.

When I returned to school from convention, I was super ready to make a difference. One thing that was made evident as I began my term as chapter president was how many younger kids lacked an understanding of what FFA was. Our chapter officer team decided to start a Jr. FFA chapter to get the kids more involved in agriculture and hopefully ensure more members for the future of the Saltillo FFA chapter. But more than anything, I wanted to teach them about servant leadership, because everything we do revolves around it.

This spring our chapter is going to host a Hopkins County wide "drive in movie" for the local FFA chapters. We are charging for admission and all the proceeds are going to the local food pantry in Hopkins County. We are also starting our own "Blue Jackets, Bright Futures" scholarship for two deserving senior FFA members attending Saltillo high school who have shown to be outstanding individuals with servant leadership qualities.



I honestly believe that without the skills I learned at convention, the impact my officer team had this year would not have been as great as it was. My FFA and Ambassador experiences have helped me confirm my career decision in agricultural education and agricultural communications.
