Convention Facts

Convention attendance broke the record with more than 14,000 members and guests at the Fort Worth Convention Center in 2019! Guest attendance is comprised of family members, school administrators, VIPs, board members and business representatives. We believe the 93rd Annual Texas FFA Convention will set a new record because of the opportunity for all Texas FFA members, parents, teachers, sponsors, and stakeholders.

The Texas FFA Convention now ranks among the Top 5 Association conventions in the state of Texas.

More than 2,500 students are recognized on-stage at convention. Attendance for the last three years has averaged more than 13,000! The FFA convention has an annual economic impact estimated at \$6.5 million to the host city! This warrants sizeable media attention and exposure for participating sponsors.

The Texas FFA Convention is the largest youth led convention in Texas. More than \$2.3 million in scholarships are awarded annually.





Texas FFA Philanthropy, Marketplace, and Talent Source

- 2019-20 membership established a new record with more than 139,815 FFA members in Texas high schools.
- Texas FFA membership accounts for approximately 18% of the national membership.
- 1 in every 6 FFA members in the United States now resides in Texas.
- There are approximately 1,079 active Texas FFA chapters.

- Approximately 214,278 high school students are enrolled in agricultural science and technology courses.
- More than 49 courses are offered in agricultural science education.
- Texas FFA is a culturally diverse organization with equal opportunities for all Texas high school students.
- More than one-third of Texas FFA members are female.

- Approximately 26% of students enrolled in agricultural science courses are minority students. (latest numbers reported by the Texas Education Agency)
- There are approximately 2,395 agricultural science teachers in Texas.

- All rules, guidelines, and requirements of usage of the FFA logo, marks and emblem are at the direction of the Texas FFA Association and National FFA Organization.


